**“Dos” & “Don’ts”!**

**How to participate actively at Mass to gain the fullness of Grace!**

“You will be filled with God’s Spirit only in proportion as you actively participate in the Mass” (cf. Pope Pius X)

To participate actively in Mass you must first **offer the Divine Victim** (Jesus Christ) to the Eternal Father in union with the Priest. Secondly, you must **offer yourself totally** to the Eternal Father in union with the Divine Victim. To be a co-offerer with the priest you must have a **sacrificial will**, so as to make the twofold oblation of Christ and yourself to the Eternal Father.

**Do:** - It is very good practice to arrive at the Church at least 10minutes before Mass begins, to place yourself in the presence of God and pray to the Holy Spirit to help you prepare your heart in anticipation for the offering of the Holy Mass.

**Do:** - It is very good to join in the prayers, responses and singing of the hymns

**Don’t:** - It is not a good practice to rush out of Mass before the final blessing and dismissal. It gives the impression you are in hurry to leave the presence of the Eternal Father in whose celebration you are privilege to have been invited to participate for your salvation. Pray with the Psalmist: *“One thing I ask from the LORD, this only do I seek: that I may dwell in the house of the LORD all the days of my life, to gaze on the beauty of the LORD ...” Psalm 27:4*

**Please do not rush out of the presence of the LORD before the Final Blessing.

**GOSPEL REFLECTION from a Parishioner**

**THE GOSPEL OF MARK 4:35-41**

How can we fight fear with faith? Jesus' sleeping presence on the storm tossed sea reveals the sleeping faith of his disciples. They feared for their lives even though their Lord and Master is with them in the boat. The Lord is ever present to us. And in our time of testing he asks the same question: Why are you afraid? Have you no faith? Do you recognize the Lord's presence with you? Believing is only possible by grace and the help of the Holy Spirit, who moves the heart and who opens the eyes of the mind to understand and accept the truth which God has revealed to us.

*"Lord, increase my faith in your redeeming love and power that I may always recognize your abiding presence with me. And give me courage to do your will in all circumstances". Amen.*
