From the Catechism of the Catholic Church

"It is then we must turn to the *witnesses of faith*: to Abraham, who "in hope... believed against hope"; to the Virgin Mary, who, in "her pilgrimage of faith", walked into the "night of faith" in sharing the darkness of her son's suffering and death; and to so many others: "Therefore, since we are surrounded by so great a cloud of witnesses, let us also lay aside every weight, and sin which clings so closely, and let us run with perseverance the race that is set before us, looking to Jesus the pioneer and perfecter of our faith." (CCC, 165)

GOSPEL REFLECTION (MATTHEW 10: 26-33)

When Jesus sent his disciples on mission to announce the Kingdom of God, to cure the sick and expel demons, he knew that they would run into opposition and even experience persecution. Jesus challenged and encouraged them not to be afraid of anybody. They were open to proclaim the message of the Kingdom to all and sundry. Jesus repeated that they were not to fear any human being but rather to have a filial fear for God.

If God's providential care extends to the cheapest life – sparrows – how much more will He not care for the people who dedicate their lives to the spreading of his reign on earth? Those who suffer death for witnessing to the good news will never be neglected by God. They will receive salvation for their dedication and faithfulness to God. There is therefore no need to be afraid. The disciple is worth more than thousands of sparrows. Jesus then added that how we react to him and his message will determine our future destiny regarding our salvation. We cannot be quiet about the good news. Let us proclaim the good news in charity in season and out of season.
