### From the Catechism of the Catholic Church

"The way of perfection passes by way of the Cross. There is no holiness without renunciation and spiritual battle. Spiritual progress entails the ascessis and mortification that gradually lead to living in the peace and joy of the Beatitudes:

He who climbs never stops going from beginning to beginning, through beginnings that have no end. He never stops desiring what he already knows. (CCC, 2015)

### **GOSPEL REFLECTION (Matthew 10: 37-42)**

Jesus wants nothing to come between him and his followers – total allegiance or commitment to Jesus or nothing else. The German Lutheran pastor, Dietrich Bonhoeffer, who was imprisoned and put to death by the Nazi regime in Germany, once said in his book, The Cost of Discipleship: "The cross creates division ( in the institution where one is to experience unity). God's love for man means the cross and the way of discipleship. But that cross and that way are both life and resurrections".

Jesus promises his disciples that their mission will not be ineffectual. Whoever welcomes Christ's messengers (whether apostles, prophets or disciples) will be rewarded with eternal life. To be worthy of that reward, one must take up one's cross and follow Jesus. Like a condemned criminal, the follower or disciple of Christ abdicates all personal ties and rights. If need be, he or she is willing to die for Christ.
