From the Catechism of the Catholic Church

"Nothing is more apt to confirm our faith and hope than holding it fixed in our minds that nothing is impossible with God. Once our reason has grasped the idea of God's almighty power, it will easily and without any hesitation admit everything that [the Creed] will afterwards propose for us to believe - even if they be great and marvellous things, far above the ordinary laws of nature." (CCC, 274)

GOSPEL REFLECTION (MATTHEW 11: 25-30)

Jesus blesses the Father for revealing the mysteries/secrets of the kingdom to babes or the simple and hiding them from the learned and the clever. God always reveals himself to the simple, babes and to people who are ready to receive him. Matthew then informs us that it is Jesus who reveals the Father. He is the exclusive revelation of the Father.

Jesus then invites us to shelter under his dominion. One must find rest in Jesus before attempting to obey the laws as Jesus expounds it. We are to shoulder his yoke and learn from him. 'Yoke' refers to Jesus' interpretation of the law. If one does not accept Jesus' interpretation of the law and be a lifelong learner, the keeping of the law will become a terrible burden or bondage. Jesus' yoke is easy for "his commandments are not difficult". Jesus Christ is the fullest interpretation and expression of God's law.
