From the Catechism of the Catholic Church

GOSPEL REFLECTION (MATTHEW 14: 22-33)

Although Jesus Christ is always with us, we sometimes think that he is very far away from us. Unfortunately, they believed in their own fears than believing in Jesus Christ. Like the disciples, we tend to forget or misunderstand the significance of Jesus' work in our lives. We are inclined to believe in our own fears than in the power and the promises of Jesus.

Jesus invites us to be focused on him alone and not on the strong winds of life which will surely frighten us. When we seem to be overawed by the storms of life such as frequent unexplained deaths in our families and sickness, we are to call out to Jesus like Peter; "Lord, save me". May we come to believe in Jesus Christ that he is closer to us more than we can imagine.
