### From the CATECHISM of the CATHOLIC CHURCH

"The Holy Spirit makes us *discern* between trials, which are necessary for the growth of the inner man, and temptation, which leads to sin and death. We must also discern between being tempted and consenting to temptation. Finally, discernment unmasks the lie of temptation, whose object appears to be good, a "delight to the eyes" and desirable, when in reality its fruit is death.

God does not want to impose the good, but wants free beings. . . . There is a certain usefulness to temptation. No one but God knows what our soul has received from him, not even we ourselves. But temptation reveals it in order to teach us to know ourselves, and in this way we discover our evil inclinations and are obliged to give thanks for the goods that temptation has revealed to us. (CCC, 2847)

### **GOSPEL REFLECTION (MATTHEW 4: 1-11)**

Beloved in Christ, in our daily relationships with God and neighbour we are faced with countless moments of temptation to sin against God and neighbour. We are bombarded with choices of being obedient to God or not, accepting him or rejecting him.

Just as Adam and Eve were tempted by Satan to disobey, so also was Jesus tempted to disobey his Father. However, unlike Adam and Eve, Jesus disobeyed the tempter and was rather obedient to his Father.

In the first temptation, the devil sought to draw away Jesus from submitting to his Father. Turning stones into bread would amount to the sin of rebellion or disobedience against the divine will, like the sin of Adam and Eve. In quoting Deut. 8:3, Jesus affirmed his total dependence on his Father. The word of God is made the chief nourishment: "Man shall not live by bread alone but on every word that comes from the mouth of God".

In the second temptation, the tempter urged a public display of Jesus' messiahship. Jesus responded that he who really trusts the Father will trust him – not test – his word.

In the third temptation, the tempter falsely promised Jesus power and wealth, should he do him homage. Jesus recognized that worship should not be divided between God and Satan. God alone is worthy of our worship (c.f. Deut. 6:13). What choices do we make in life?
