FROM THE CATECHISM OF THE CATHOLIC CHURCH

The practice of all the virtues is animated and inspired by charity, which "binds everything together in perfect harmony";1 it is the *form of the virtues*; it articulates and orders them among themselves; it is the source and the goal of their Christian practice. Charity upholds and purifies our human ability to love, and raises it to the supernatural perfection of divine love. CCC 1827

GOSPEL REFLECTION (MATTHEW 18: 21-22)

Can we forgive the one who causes us so much pain? Can we forgive the one who is bent on destroying our life? "Not seven times, I tell you, but seventy-seven times". Jesus invites us to forgive those who sin against us unlimitedly just as our heavenly Father forgives us our many sins. There is no denying the fact that forgiveness is one of the most difficult and painful virtues in Christianity.

The basis of forgiveness is the appreciation of what God has done for humanity in his Son who died on the cross for our sins. In the story of the unforgiving servant, he failed to appreciate how much he had been forgiven by his master, about one million pound sterling. He was rather bent on getting back the one pound sterling his fellow servant owed him. While his attention should have been on the priceless forgiveness he had received from his master, he was absorbed and obsessed with the paltry sum of money his fellow servant owed him. "He seized him by the throat and began to throttle him..., he had him thrown into prison till he should pay the debt". May the passion of our saviour gradually melt away all the pain, hurt, resentment, revenge and the anger we bear against those who sin against us.

May the crucified Lord grant us the courage to dare to forgive those who sin against us so that we may also receive the Lord's forgiveness. "And that is how my heavenly Father will deal with you unless you each forgive your brother or sister from your heart......
