GOSPEL REFLECTION (MATTHEW 20: 1-16)

The generous love of God cannot be measured by any human standard. It is incalculable and beyond human reckoning. An attitude which was rife during the time of Jesus and still prevalent is the opinion that God owes us salvation after we have done our 'good works'; like a child who thinks his father 'owes' her money for every job done.

God does not owe salvation to anyone. None of us deserves anything from God; God is not indebted to anyone for any good thing done. Everything we have and receive from God – life and salvation – is a free gift graciously bestowed on us. In the parable of the labourers in the vineyard, the master was not wicked to those who were hired first but was generous to those who were hired last.
