FROM THE CATECHISM OF THE CATHOLIC CHURCH

"At all times and in every race, anyone who fears God and does what is right has been acceptable to him. He has, however, willed to make men holy and save them, not as individuals without any bond or link between them, but rather to make them into a people who might acknowledge him and serve him in holiness. He therefore chose the Israelite race to be his own people and established a covenant with it. He gradually instructed this people.... All these things, however, happened as a preparation for and figure of that new and perfect covenant which was to be ratified in Christ . . . the New Covenant in his blood; he called together a race made up of Jews and Gentiles which would be one, not according to the flesh, but in the Spirit." (CCC781)

GOSPEL REFLECTION (MATTHEW 21: 33-43)

The Parable of the wicked tenants uses the analogy of the vineyard to describe God's relationship with his people. The vineyard is Jerusalem, the tenants are the religious leaders, the slaves are the prophets and the son, Jesus Christ. It is the responsibility of the religious leaders to nurture spiritual growth and fruitfulness among the peoples. This is the fruit the owner's slaves, that is, the prophets are sent to collect. The maltreatment of the prophets is well attested in the Old Testament, for example, Jeremiah.

As the tenants sought to get rid of the son and the heir, so the chief priests were planning to get rid of Jesus. Since Israel rejects Jesus as the Messiah, the Kingdom of God will be taken from them and handed to the Gentiles who will yield a good harvest. The resurrection of the one whom they will cast out and kill will be turning point that will lead to the kingdom being taken away from the religious leaders and given to a people who will produce the fruits of it.
