#### From the CATECHISM of the CATHOLIC CHURCH

"Pray constantly . . . always and for everything giving thanks in the name of our Lord Jesus Christ to God the Father." St. Paul adds, "Pray at all times in the Spirit, with all prayer and supplication. To that end keep alert with all perseverance making supplication for all the saints." For "we have not been commanded to work, to keep watch and to fast constantly, but it has been laid down that we are to pray without ceasing." This tireless fervour can come only from love. Against our dullness and laziness, the battle of prayer is that of humble, trusting, and persevering love. This love opens our hearts to three enlightening and life-giving facts of faith about prayer. (CCC, 2742)

#### **GOSPEL REFLECTION (Luke 17: 11-19)**

For the Israelites in today's first reading, while Moses prayed, they were successful; when he stopped, they began to fail. Jesus presents a similar view on prayer. If, like the widow in the Gospel, we persist, God will give us what we ask for.

Jesus, in the Gospel, tells us the true meaning of prayer, never to lose heart. We may never know why God seems to intervene in response to some prayers and not to others. Prayer always takes place in the context of a lived relationship with God. The greatest prayer, the Our Father, asks simply: "Thy will be done". That is the basis of all prayers. If we pray and truly believe that God's will, and only God's will alone, will bring us happiness, then we will never lose heart in our prayer and in our relationship with God, whatever the apparent outcome of our prayer. In the Garden of Gethsemane, Jesus prayed: "Father, if you are willing, take this cup away from me. Nevertheless, let your will be done, not mine". That prayer was persistent and trusting. Jesus' prayer did not save him from the cross, but it did lead to the resurrection. If we can pray with Jesus' faith, we will never lose heart; for if God's will is done, then our victory is assured and our prayers are answered.
