From the Parish Priest

Dear Brothers and Sisters,

May the Grace and blessings of the Season of Lent be with you!

"On the threshold of public life: the Baptism; on the threshold of the Passover: the Transfiguration. Jesus' baptism proclaimed 'the mystery of the first regeneration,' namely, our Baptism; the Transfiguration 'is the sacrament of the second regeneration': our own Resurrection. From now on we share in the Lord's Resurrection through the Spirit who acts in the sacraments of the Body of Christ. The Transfiguration gives us a foretaste of Christ's glorious coming, when he 'will change our lowly body to be like his glorious body.' But it also recalls that 'it is through many persecutions that we must enter the kingdom of God.'" (CCC, cf. 556)

Beloved, by the Transfiguration, Christ Jesus manifests His glory, showing through the law (Moses) and the prophets (Elijah) that, His passion will lead to the glory of the resurrection. Let us therefore, turn to the Lord who graciously calls us and enlightens us through His Beloved Son, Christ Jesus, who comes to us, in the Word and in the Sacrament, to save us and call us to be Holy.

May God's love remain with us as we place our hope and trust in Him.

Gospel Reflection from a Parishioner

The Holy Gospel of Matthew 17: 1 - 9

Jesus took His favourite Apostles; Peter, James and John, up a high mountain to pray and be alone.

Jesus wanted them to see HIS DIVINITY by His Transfiguration, and with His Spiritual Connection with Moses and Elijah; His great forerunners, who were hero's to the Apostles. The Father said "This is My Beloved Son, listen to HIM". Peter wanted to remain there forever.
