From the CATECHISM OF THE CATHOLIC CHURCH

For a moment Jesus discloses his divine glory, confirming Peter's confession. He also reveals that he will have to go by the way of the cross at Jerusalem in order to "enter into his glory". Moses and Elijah had seen God's glory on the Mountain; the Law and the Prophets had announced the Messiah's sufferings. Christ's Passion is the will of the Father: the Son acts as God's servant; the cloud indicates the presence of the Holy Spirit. "The whole Trinity appeared: the Father in the voice; the Son in the man; the Spirit in the shining cloud."

You were transfigured on the mountain, and your disciples, as much as they were capable of it, beheld your glory, O Christ our God, so that when they should see you crucified they would understand that your Passion was voluntary, and proclaim to the world that you truly are the splendour of the Father. (CCC,555)

Gospel Reflection from a Parishioner Holy Gospel of Luke 9: 28 – 36

Jesus took Peter, John and James and went up the mountain to pray. While he was praying his face changed in appearance and his clothing became dazzling white....Peter and his companions had been overcome by sleep, but becoming fully awake, they saw his glory and the two men standing with him. Peter said to Jesus, "Master, it is good for us to be here; let us make three tents, one for you, one for Moses and one for Elijah." But he did not know what he was saying. While he was speaking ,a cloud came and cast a shadow over them...Then from the cloud came a voice that said ,"This is my chosen Son, listen to him." After the voice had spoken, Jesus was found alone.

Christ appeared in the splendour of a vision to his disciples, -- MAY WE FIND THE FACE OF JESUS IN ORDINARY EVENTS OF OUR LIFE.
