FROM THE CATECHISM OF THE CATHOLIC CHURCH

Jesus said to his disciples: "Love one another even as I have loved you." In response to the question about the first of the commandments, Jesus says: "The first is, 'Hear, O Israel: The Lord our God, the Lord is one; and you shall love the Lord your God with all your heart, and with all your soul, and with all your mind, and with all your strength.' The second is this, 'You shall love your neighbour as yourself.' There is no other commandment greater than these." 2

The apostle St. Paul reminds us of this: "He who loves his neighbour has fulfilled the law. The commandments, 'You shall not commit adultery, You shall not kill, You shall not steal, You shall not covet,' and any other commandment, are summed up in this sentence, 'You shall love your neighbour as yourself.' Love does no wrong to a neighbour; therefore love is the fulfilling of the law."3 ccc 2196

GOSPEL REFLECTION (MATTHEW 22: 34-40)

Our gospel reading today is the fusion of two Old Testament texts; love of God (Duet. 6:5) and love of neighbour (Lev. 19:18). The novelty in these two commandments is that one cannot be practiced without the other. Love of God necessarily implies love of neighbour and there can be no true love of neighbour without any reference to God. Jesus affirms that every detail of the Law and our lives depend on love of God and neighbour.

To understand this, we must ask God to teach us what love is and is not. God teaches us what love is in his son Jesus Christ. The birth, ministry, suffering, death and resurrection of Jesus will forever be the paradigm of love for us. Proven to himself to be just what they insincerely affirmed to him at the beginning of the gospel; "Master, we know that you are an honest man and teach the way of God in an honest way..."
