From the CATECHISM of the CATHOLIC CHURCH

"Lay people also fulfil their prophetic mission by evangelization, "that is, the proclamation of Christ by word and the testimony of life." For lay people, "this evangelization. . . acquires a specific property and peculiar efficacy because it is accomplished in the ordinary circumstances of the world."

"This witness of life, however, is not the sole element in the apostolate; the true apostle is on the lookout for occasions of announcing Christ by word, either to unbelievers ... or to the faithful" (CCC, 905)

GOSPEL REFLECTION (MATTHEW 4: 12-23)

Matthew situates the beginning of Jesus' public ministry after the arrest of John the Baptist, specifically in the lakeside town of Capernaum where Jesus makes his home. In his extensive movements, Jesus will frequent this place. For Matthew who sees Jesus Christ as the fulfilment of the prophecies of the prophets, the settling of Jesus in Capernaum is a fulfilment of the prophecy of Isaiah. Zebulun and Naphtali, the two northernmost tribes were the first to be defeated by the Assyrians. But the Lord will turn defeat and humiliation into glory by the coming of the Messiah of David. Although Zebulun and Naphtali had rejected David's dynasty in favour of Jeroboam (c.f I Kg. 12:1-20), their salvation will come from the very one whom they rejected.

The beginning of Jesus' ministry is marked by a decisive call to repentance for one to participate in the Kingdom of God. The call to repentance is not a one-off but rather a continuous and a daily affair. May Jesus Christ, the Light who shone on Naphtali and Zebulun shine in our lives that we will be a light for other men and women.
