From the CATECHISM OF THE CATHOLIC CHURCH

"Justified in the name of the Lord Jesus Christ and in the Spirit of our God," "sanctified . . . [and] called to be saints," Christians have become the temple of the Holy Spirit. Healing the wounds of sin, the Holy Spirit renews us interiorly through a spiritual transformation. He enlightens and strengthens us to live as "children of light" through "all that is good and right and true." (CCC, 1695)

Gospel Reflection from a Parishioner Holy Gospel of Luke 1; 1 - 4 and Luke 4: 14 - 21
