Gospel Reflection from a Parishioner

The Holy Gospel of John 4: 5 - 42

Water is one of the greatest gifts of GOD to the World. Baptism is a time of preparation, today Jesus is offering us a new kind of water, LIVING - WATER.

He sat by Jacob's well thirsty after His trek from Judea to the Samaritan town of Sychar. Something is moving in the Heart of Jesus; a parching thirst for the human heart.

The woman is surprised to be addressed by Him when He asked her (a Samaritan) "Give me a drink". He wants to awaken a new thirst by this "whoever drinks the water I shall give will never thirst; it will become in them a Spring, welling up to eternal life". She asked how she could get and drink this Living Water. Jesus told her to come to him with a thirst, trust and belief and HE would open up the well to her.

Lent means spring, habitual sins block the flow of water, Confession allows the Spirit of Grace to pour into hearts to wash away the muck.

Jesus is the Spring, out of HIM pours streams of living water.

The Spirit is the shower and waves which fill the heart to open it again, springing it back into life.
