#### From the CATECHISM of the CATHOLIC CHURCH

"The Father's only Son, conceived as man in the womb of the Virgin Mary, is "Christ", that is to say, anointed by the Holy Spirit, from the beginning of his human existence, though the manifestation of this fact takes place only progressively: to the shepherds, to the magi, to John the Baptist, to the disciples. Thus the whole life of Jesus Christ will make manifest "how God anointed Jesus of Nazareth with the Holy Spirit and with power." (CCC, 486)

# **GOSPEL REFLECTION (MATTHEW 1: 18-24)**

As the period of Advent gradually draws to a close we are reminded today that Emmanuel, God is with us to share in our lives and save us and we need only to trust in him. Matthew relates the manner of Jesus' birth. He stresses the divine conception of Jesus through the agency of the Holy Spirit. Joseph, being a man of honour, decides to divorce Mary informally for he knows that he is not responsible for the pregnancy. The irony is that being a man of honour, Joseph had to insist on following the dictates of the Law, that is, Mary should be stoned for playing the adulteress (cf. Deut. 22:20-21).

Joseph, however, tempers justice with compassion. He decides to divorce her quietly. The angel of the Lord then explains to Joseph in a dream why Mary is not an adulteress. The name, 'Jesus' to be given to the child means "Saviour" or "God saves". He is the one to save his people from their sins. This is to fulfil the promise of the Lord through his prophet Isaiah: "The virgin will conceive and give birth to a son and they will call him Emmanuel, meaning, God is with us". The meaning of the name which will appear at the end of the book implies the ever presence of God with his people.
