From the CATECHISM OF THE CATHOLIC CHURCH

Faith makes us taste in advance the light of the beatific vision, the goal of our journey here below. Then we shall see God "face to face", "as he is". So faith is already the beginning of eternal life:

'When we contemplate the blessings of faith even now, as if gazing at a reflection in a mirror, it is as if we already possessed the wonderful things which our faith assures us we shall one day enjoy'" (CCC, 163)

Gospel Reflection from a Parishioner Holy Gospel of Luke 4:21-30

As the crowds doubted who Jesus was because of his simple origins, so will others doubt who we are if we courageously live the gospel. No matter what simple origins we might have, our living the gospel is what shape our everyday choices. This means, for example, that if the chatter around the coffee machine at work grows uncharitable or course, we have the courage to walk away. If prejudice exists among our friends and acquaintances, we have the courage to extol the dignity of the minority. We are called to place gospel values before any other values and to be willing to put our lives on the line for them. Jesus said "AMEN, I say to you, no prophet is accepted in his own native place."

Characteristics and Functions of the Missionaries of Mercy The Missionaries are to be:

- 1 a living sign of the Father's welcome to all those in search of his forgiveness;
- 2 facilitators for all, with no one excluded, of a truly human encounter, a source of liberation, rich with responssibility for overcoming obstacles and taking up the new life of Baptism again;
- 3 guided by the words, "For God has consigned all to disobedience, that he may have mercy upon all";
- 4 inspiring preachers of Mercy;
- 5 heralds of the joy of forgiveness;
- 6 welcoming, loving, and compassionate Confessors, who are most especially attentive to the difficult situations of each person.

Functions: The Missionaries will be invited by individual Diocesan Bishops within their particular country to give missions or facilitate specific initiatives organized for the Jubilee, with a particular attention given to the Sacrament of Reconciliation. The Holy Father will grant these Missionaries the authority to pardon even those sins reserved to the Holy See.
