"When St. Peter confessed that Jesus is the Christ, the Son of the living God, Jesus declared to him that this revelation did not come "from flesh and blood", but from "my Father who is in heaven". Faith is a gift of God, a supernatural virtue infused by him. "Before this faith can be exercised, man must have the grace of God to move and assist him; he must have the interior helps of the Holy Spirit, who moves the heart and converts it to God, who opens the eyes of the mind and 'makes it easy for all to accept and believe the truth."" (CCC, 153)

GOSPEL REFLECTION (JOHN 9: 1-41)

As we journey through this life, we are often assailed with fears, doubts and dilemmas. Jesus Christ, our Shepherd-King cures our blindness and lights up the way for us.

The cure of the blind man offers us insights into the need for us to be cured of our blindness in order to make fresh commitments to Jesus Christ. Jesus did not agree with his disciples that it was somebody's sin which caused the man's blindness. His answer was: "he was blind so that the works of God might be displayed in him". God permitted the man to be born blind.

The Pharisees were upset that Jesus had cured on the Sabbath. For them, Jesus was a sinner. Others did not agree: "how could a sinner produce signs like this?" While the Pharisees were hard at it to discredit Jesus as the Messiah, the man born blind saw him as a prophet, a man of God or someone from God: "if this man were not from God, he could not do a thing". At the end of the story we realize that it was the Pharisees who were blind for their refusal to believe in Jesus Christ. They still remained in darkness.

Let us come to Jesus Christ to heal us of all forms of blindness.
