# From the Catechism of the Catholic Church

"Christ, high priest and unique mediator, has made of the Church "a kingdom, priests for his God and Father." The whole community of believers is, as such, priestly. The faithful exercise their baptismal priesthood through their participation, each according to his own vocation, in Christ's mission as priest, prophet, and king. Through the sacraments of Baptism and Confirmation the faithful are "consecrated to be ... a holy priesthood." (CCC, 1546)

## **GOSPEL REFLECTIONS**

As Jesus was about to depart from this world, he assured his disciples that he was going to prepare a place for them in heaven so that they would be with him in his Father's house. He reminded Thomas and the other disciples that he is the Way, the Truth, meaning the Life to the Father. He is the only way to the Father. There is no other way. In Acts 4:12, Peter told the Sanhedrin that Jesus is the only name by which one is to be saved.

In answer to Philip's question: "Lord, let us see the Father and then we shall be satisfied"; Jesus clearly relates the unique relationship between him and the Father. The Father is present in the Son; "To have seen me is to have seen the Father". This unique relationship validates Jesus' words and works. The words he has spoken are from the Father and the works he has accomplished are the works of the Father. Those who believe in this peculiar relationship between the Father and the Son will be enabled to do similar works of the Son and even greater works than he has done. The Father and the Son share the same divinity, they share the same words and works. Jesus has revealed to us all that we want to know, learn or hear from the Father. In Jesus Christ the Son, we see the true identity or revelation of God, the Father.
