### From the CATECHISM of the CATHOLIC CHURCH

"The origin and purpose of mission. The Lord's missionary mandate is ultimately grounded in the eternal love of the Most Holy Trinity: "The Church on earth is by her nature missionary since, according to the plan of the Father, she has as her origin the mission of the Son and the Holy Spirit." The ultimate purpose of mission is none other than to make men share in the communion between the Father and the Son in their Spirit of love." (CCC, 850)

## **GOSPEL REFLECTION (MATTHEW 5: 13-16)**

Jesus Christ symbolizes our lives as Christians with two essential items; salt and light. The comparison with salt and light shows the positive influence of our lives as Christians. Kingdom citizens, like salt and light are to be useful.

Salt is used for flavouring and preserving. It makes food taste well. Disciples are to be the sweetening and tasty elements in the community. Salt also preserves certain food items from going bad. Disciples are to prevent the quality of life from getting bad. But if salt loses its saltiness, it is bad and cannot retain its usefulness. Disciples lose their usefulness if they do not sweeten and preserve society.

The usefulness of light is to drive away darkness. Without light there will always be darkness. God first created light. "Let there be light, and there was light" (Gen.1:3). As light, disciples are to drive away darkness for people to see clearly. The world must see us Disciples of Christ, as light that leads others from darkness to light. Christians are expected to be useful like salt and light.
