From the CATECHISM of the CATHOLIC CHURCH

Christ will raise us up "on the last day"; but it is also true that, in a certain way, we have already risen with Christ. For, by virtue of the Holy Spirit, Christian life is already now on earth a participation in the death and Resurrection of Christ:

And you were buried with him in Baptism, in which you were also raised with him through faith in the working of God, who raised him from the dead . . . If then you have been raised with Christ, seek the things that are above, where Christ is, seated at the right hand of God. (CCC, 1002)

GOSPEL REFLECTION (JOHN 11:1-45)

As creatures of God and Christians, we owe our existence from Him. Without God, we are dead and with no real life. Although Christ loves Lazarus and his sisters and receives the message of his sickness, he stays on for two more days. The purpose is clear. Jesus has authority over life and death and the raising of Lazarus will point to Jesus as the giver of life to all those who believe in him.

When Martha meets Jesus, she voices the common expectation. The one who loves Lazarus and is well known for his miracles should have been able to heal him: "he opened the eyes of the blind man, could he not have prevented this man's death?" Martha then expresses her belief in the future resurrection of the dead. Jesus promises her the realized resurrection which begins here and now for those who believe in him. Jesus' show of distress is a reaction to the mourners who probably fail to understand the import of the whole event. He further rebukes Martha for her unbelief. The prayer Jesus offers underscores his relationship with the Father. Jesus then finally calls Lazarus to life. The drama of Jesus raising Lazarus to life is a fulfillment of his earlier words. He is the giver of life and for those who believe in him, eternal life begins here on this earth.
