From the CATECHISM of the CATHOLIC CHURCH

"The New Law is called a law of love because it makes us act out of the love infused by the Holy Spirit, rather than from fear; a law of grace, because it confers the strength of grace to act, by means of faith and the sacraments; a law of freedom, because it sets us free from the ritual and juridical observances of the Old Law, inclines us to act spontaneously by the prompting of charity and, finally, lets us pass from the condition of a servant who "does not know what his master is doing" to that of a friend of Christ - "For all that I have heard from my Father I have made known to you" - or even to the status of son and heir." (CCC, 1972)

GOSPEL REFLECTION (MATTHEW 5: 17-37)

One of the challenges that face any human group is the enactment and enforcement of laws. Jesus Christ affirms the importance of the Law and the Prophets in our relationship with one another and in our relationship with God. The Law and the Prophets find their fulfillment and completion in Jesus who invites us to keep them.

Unlike human laws which are always tainted with issues of selfishness and oppression, the laws of Christ contain the hidden wisdom of God. They are laws motivated and given by love, and can only be fulfilled by genuine love and true concern for others. Hence Christ stresses that, "if your virtue goes no deeper than that of the Scribes and Pharisees, you will never get into the kingdom of heaven". The motivation behind the fulfillment of the laws must always be love and not a slavish obedience. Christ therefore draws our attention to examine the intentions and motivations behind the infringement of laws such as murder, adultery and divorce and breaking of oaths.
