From the CATECHISM of the CATHOLIC CHURCH

GOSPEL REFLECTION (MATTHEW 14: 13-21)

We are sometimes consumed by anxiety, worry and fear because of our lack of trust in the tremendous love of God for us. Unfortunately, we gain nothing from our worry and fear. We do not eliminate all the sources of our fears; for they will always be with us and we do not increase our life-span for all our worrying. We even reduce our life-span. Christ reminds us that we cannot be the slave both of God and money. Divided allegiance or attention between God and money is impossible. However, slavery to God brings perfect freedom as he provides us with all that we need.

If God cares for flowers in the fields, how much more will He not care for us created in his own image? We usually lack faith in God. We doubt his power to accomplish what He has promised for us. We must busy ourselves with God's kingdom; on His righteousness and obedience to him, and whatever we need for our sustenance will be provided. Let us dare to trust in God's providence.
