### JUBILEE YEAR OF MERCY 8th December 2015 - 20th November 2016

The Holy Father, Pope Francis on Divine Mercy Sunday 2015, published a Papal Bull entitled "Misericordiare Vultus" (The Face of Mercy) in which he established that from the Feast of the Immaculate Conception 8<sup>th</sup> December 2015 until 20th November 2016 the Church will keep an extraordinary Jubilee Year of Mercy. ### From the CATECHISM OF THE CATHOLIC CHURCH

Heaven is the ultimate end and fulfillment of the deepest human longings, the state of supreme, definitive happiness." (CCC,1024)

# Gospel Reflection from a Parishioner The Holy Gospel of Mark 12: 28 - 34

In this gospel a scribe approaches Jesus with the question, one about which of the 613 Jewish precepts is greatest. Jesus gets to the heart of things, and does more than just answers the scribe's question; he brings to explicit statement the whole underlying meaning of his ministry and what discipleship and inaugurating the kingdom of God is all about. Knowing the law and even keeping the law are not enough -- what is required is whole - hearted love of God and neighbour.

Jesus in addition to the commandment to love God above all else, tells his listeners to "love your neighbour as yourself." What links our relationship to God, neighbour, and self is love. Law is not kept for its own sake; ideally, law sustains and protects relationships in a loving way.

O Lord, teach us how to love God with all our soul, with all our mind, and with all our strength,

- AND OUR NEIGHBOUR AS OURSELVES. AMEN.
