Immaculate Conception:

From the CATECHISM OF THE CATHOLIC CHURCH

“**Worship of the Eucharist!** In the liturgy of the Mass we express our faith in the real presence of Christ under the species of bread and wine by, among other ways, genuflecting or bowing deeply as a sign of adoration of the Lord. ‘The Catholic Church has always offered and still offers to the sacrament of the Eucharist the cult of adoration, not only during Mass, but also outside of it, reserving the consecrated hosts with the utmost care, exposing them to the solemn veneration of the faithful, and carrying them in procession.’” (CCC, 1378)

“It is highly fitting that Christ should have wanted to remain present to his Church in a unique way. Since Christ was about to take his departure from his own in his visible form, he wanted to give us his sacramental presence; since he is about to offer himself on the cross to save us, he wanted us to have a memorial of the love with which he loved us ‘to the end,’ even to the giving of his life. In his Eucharistic presence he remains mysteriously in our midst as the one who loved us and gave himself up for us, and he remains under signs that express and communicate this love: “ The Church and the world has a great need for Eucharistic worship. Jesus awaits us in this sacrament of love. Let us not refuse the time to go to meet him in adoration, in contemplation full of faith, and open to making amends for the serious offenses and crimes of the world. Let our adoration never cease.”” (CCC, 1380)

GOSPEL REFLECTION *from a Parishioner*

The Body & Blood of Christ. Holy Gospel of Mark 14 : 12 - 16, 22 - 26

Why did Jesus offer himself as "food and drink" to his disciples? Jesus chose the time of Passover to fulfil what he had announced earlier at Capernaum - giving his disciples his body and his blood.

Jesus' passing over to his Father by his death and resurrection, the new Passover, is anticipated in the Last Supper and celebrated in the Eucharist or Lord's Supper, which fulfils the Jewish Passover and anticipates the final Passover of the church in the glory of God's kingdom.

CORPUS CHRISTI PROCESSION will take place at Ebbw Vale Town Centre at 11.30am and will end with Benediction at All Saints Church. There will be a Buffet/Barbecue in the Parish Hall and grounds afterwards. There will also be a procession at 2.30pm in Bute Park, Cardiff. All are welcome!
