FROM THE CATECHISM OF THE CATHOLIC CHURCH

Though already present in his Church, Christ's reign is nevertheless yet to be fulfilled "with power and great glory" by the King's return to earth. This reign is still under attack by the evil powers, even though they have been defeated definitively by Christ's Passover. Until everything is subject to him, "until there be realized new heavens and a new earth in which justice dwells, the pilgrim Church, in her sacraments and institutions, which belong to this present age, carries the mark of this world which will pass, and she herself takes her place among the creatures which groan and travail yet and await the revelation of the sons of God." That is why Christians pray, above all in the Eucharist, to hasten Christ's return by saying to him: Marana tha! "Our Lord, come!" CCC 671

GOSPEL REFLECTION (MATTHEW 25: 31-46)

The Solemnity of Christ the King marks the end of the liturgical year. An analogy is presented between the end of the liturgical and the end of time when Christ will come again to judge. In this beautiful imaginative scene, which depicts the second coming of Christ, Matthew presents a summary of Christ's ministry and teaching – how we cared for one another and especially those who needed our care most.

The "sheep" were able to move out of their own self-centredness in order to respond with love and care for the needy. Out of a deep desire to share God's grace and blessing with the needy, they willingly gave of themselves. The "goat", on the other hand, did not open themselves to receive God's overflowing gift of love. They were too concerned for their own welfare — their own status and prestige — to look beyond themselves and bring God's love and compassion to others
