From the CATECHISM of the CATHOLIC CHURCH

The Epiphany is the manifestation of Jesus as Messiah of Israel, Son of God and Saviour of the world. The great feast of Epiphany celebrates the adoration of Jesus by the wise men (magi) from the East, together with his baptism in the Jordan and the wedding feast at Cana in Galilee. In the magi, representatives of the neighbouring pagan religions, the Gospel sees the first-fruits of the nations, who welcome the good news of salvation through the Incarnation. The magi's coming to Jerusalem in order to pay homage to the king of the Jews shows that they seek in Israel, in the messianic light of the star of David, the one who will be king of the nations. Their coming means that pagans can discover Jesus and worship him as Son of God and Saviour of the world only by turning towards the Jews and receiving from them the messianic promise as contained in the Old Testament. The Epiphany shows that "the full number of the nations" now takes its "place in the family of the patriarchs", and acquires Israelitica dignitas (is made "worthy of the heritage of Israel"). (CCC, 528)

GOSPEL REFLECTION (Matthew 2: 1-12)

People travel and pay a handsome amount of money to attend a pop show where a famous artist makes an appearance. For the Greeks the word "Epiphany" was used to describe the appearance or manifestation of a god among human beings. Today, we celebrate the appearance of the Lord Jesus Christ to the whole world. The celebration of Epiphany brings out a prominent aspect of Christmas; the manifestation of the Universal new born King.

A very superstitious Herod is upset by the enquiry made by the three Wise men. He realizes that his position and authority are under siege and about to be usurped. His quest is not to worship the new born King of the Jews but to eliminate him before he takes his position away from him. The gifts of the three Wise men have symbolic meanings: gold signifies the kingship of Christ, incense his divinity and myrrh his redemptive suffering.

May Jesus Christ, the Light of the world light up our journey of faith so that we may see clearly and make the right choices in life that we will one day see him face to face.
