From the CATECHISM of the CATHOLIC CHURCH

The *Epiphany* is the manifestation of Jesus as Messiah of Israel, Son of God and Saviour of the world. The great feast of Epiphany celebrates the adoration of Jesus by the wise men (*magi*) from the East, together with his baptism in the Jordan and the wedding feast at Cana in Galilee. In the magi, representatives of the neighbouring pagan religions, the Gospel sees the first-fruits of the nations, who welcome the good news of salvation through the Incarnation. The magi's coming to Jerusalem in order to pay homage to the king of the Jews shows that they seek in Israel, in the messianic light of the star of David, the one who will be king of the nations. Their coming means that pagans can discover Jesus and worship him as Son of God and Saviour of the world only by turning towards the Jews and receiving from them the messianic promise as contained in the Old Testament. The Epiphany shows that "the full number of the nations" now takes its "place in the family of the patriarchs", and acquires *Israelitica dignitas* (is made "worthy of the heritage of Israel"). GOSPEL REFLECTION from a Parishioner Holy Gospel of Matthew 2:1-12

When Jesus was born in Judea in the days of King Herod, the Magi arrived *asking* "where is the new born King of the Jews we have come to do him homage." Herod was deeply troubled, but the Magi stopped over the place where the child was born, they prostrated themselves and did him homage. Then they opened their treasures and offered him gifts of gold, frankincense and myrrh.

What happens if we lead our life as if the star stopped over us? The answer to this question is most startling when we consider the gospel as a whole: what it means and what happens is that the only light and life is to die to self so that darkness can be overcome.

Life has its sorrows and sufferings. It also has its joys and celebrations: the mystery of salvation has been revealed in Jesus and in us.

As the star guided the Magi, may we be guided by Your light and grace.
