Dear Brothers and Sisters,

The whole life of Christ Jesus is an offering to the Father for our salvation. Christ came down from Heaven not to do his own will but the will of the Father who sent him. It is the will of the Father that we should be sanctified through the offering of the body of Christ once and for all, for our salvation. 'I will place my Law within them and write it on their hearts;' says the Lord, and 'I will be there God and they shall be my people'.

Beloved; from the very moment Christ became man to dwell among us, he embraced the Father's plan of divine salvation in his redemptive mission. Gospel Reflection from a Parishioner

THE HOLY GOSPEL OF JOHN 12VERSES 20 - 30

As we approach Holy Week and our celebration of Christ's mystery, his death and resurrection being our opening for the fullness of life, today we read in the gospel that anyone who loves his life, loses it, and anyone who hates his life in this world will keep it for eternal life. This challenges each of us to recognise just how different a vision of life we must have if we are to serve and follow Jesus Christ.

The gospel of John is divided into two parts and with this text we approach the end of part one, sometimes known as the Book of Signs, between the end of Jesus' public life and the beginning of his passion. The scene is Jerusalem which is full of pilgrims arriving from all around the Roman empire and their request to see Jesus is a reminder that "seeing" in the fourth gospel is another way of speaking of "believing in". On the cross Jesus is drawing all people to himself and inviting a faith response to the love of God that he has manifested.

His death is like a seed of grain falling into the ground where it perishes but out of it comes a rich harvest. This is the way of love and all who follow Jesus must walk this path. By so doing they participate in God's ultimate victory over evil.
