From the Parish Priest

Dear Brothers and Sisters,

"God so loved the world that He gave His only Son so that everyone who believe in him ... may have eternal life."

Christ Jesus says 'Come to me, all you who labour and are burdened, and I will refresh you'. Again he says, 'The bread that I will give is my flesh for the life of the world.' 'Take and eat; this is my body which will be given up for you; do this in remembrance of me.' 'He who eats my flesh and drinks my blood, abides in me, and I in him.' 'The words that I have spoken to you are Spirit and life.' Do you believe this? God gives us the best gift.

Dearly beloved: "Believing is possible only by grace and the interior helps of the Holy Spirit. But it is no less true that believing is an authentically human act. Trusting in God and cleaving to the truths he has revealed is contrary neither to human freedom nor to human reason. Even in human relations it is not contrary to our dignity to believe what other persons tell us about themselves and their intentions, or to trust their promises (for example, when a man and a woman marry) to share a communion of life with one another. If it is so, still less is it contrary to our dignity to 'yield by faith the full submission of... intellect and will to God who reveals,' and to share in an interior communion with him." (CCC, 154)

The Lord is so generous with His mercy and infinitely rich in grace that, He sent His Son (the best gift for you and me) so that through him we can be saved and be brought to share eternal life with Him. Therefore, Let us in faith turn our eyes upon Jesus and follow His wonderful ways, so that we may benefit from the free gift of God that brings us to participate in the communion of life with Christ Jesus through the power of the Holy Spirit for our salvation.

May the grace of God remain with us now and for ever, Amen!

Gospel Reflection from a Parishioner GOSPEL OF JOHN 3: 14 - 21

The fourth Sunday of Lent is sometimes called Laetare Sunday. Laetare is a Latin word that means "rejoice". On this Sunday, the antiphon is taken from the book of the prophet Isaiah. Even as we observe our Lenten sacrifices, we rejoice in anticipation of the joy that will be ours at Easter.

In the part of the conversation with Nicodemus in today's Gospel, Jesus referred to an incident reported in the Old Testament. When the Israelites grumbled against the Lord during their sojourn in the desert, God sent venomous serpents to punish them for their complaints. The Israelites repented and asked Moses to pray for them. The Lord heard Moses' prayer and instructed him to make a bronze serpent and mount it on a pole. All who had been bitten by a serpent and then looked upon the bronze serpent were cured. By recalling this story, Jesus alludes to the salvation that would be accomplished through his death and Resurrection.

We have gathered here as God's holy people, and we are God's work of art, created in Jesus Christ to live the good life as from the beginning he intended us to live it. So we have to be thankful for his mercy, and sorry for our failures to live life in that way. Since this is the Fourth Sunday of Lent, today is Mothers' Day - the day when we thank our mothers for all they have done for us, and also express our sorrow for any way we have hurt them.
