But his inmost being as Holy Trinity is a mystery that is inaccessible to reason alone or even to Israel's faith before the incarnation of God's Son and the sending of the Holy Spirit." (CCC, 237)

Dearly beloved, rejoice for the Lord God is 'merciful and gracious, slow to anger, and rich in kindness and fidelity.' He has revealed his Love by giving us his only Begotten Son, so that we might have eternal life with him, through the power of his Holy Spirit.

Gospel reflection

The Holy Gospel of John 3: 16 - 18

The feast of the Most Holy Trinity is a mystery; something that one does not fully understand. Jesus converses with Nichodemus who has come to him "by night", because of his fear of the Jews.
