### **From the Catechism of the Catholic Church**

The mystery of the Most Holy Trinity is the central mystery of Christian faith and life. It is the mystery of God in himself. It is therefore the source of all the other mysteries of faith, the light that enlightens them. It is the most fundamental and essential teaching in the "hierarchy of the truths of faith". The whole history of salvation is identical with the history of the way and the means by which the one true God, Father, Son and Holy Spirit, reveals himself to men "and reconciles and unites with himself those who turn away from sin". (CCC, 234)

The Trinity is a mystery of faith in the strict sense, one of the "mysteries that are hidden in God, which can never be known unless they are revealed by God". To be sure, God has left traces of his Trinitarian being in his work of creation and in his Revelation throughout the Old Testament. But his inmost Being as Holy Trinity is a mystery that is inaccessible to reason alone or even to Israel's faith before the Incarnation of God's Son and the sending of the Holy Spirit. (CCC,237)

### **GOSPEL REFLECTION**

The Solemnity of the Holy Trinity celebrates the Three Persons in God; Father, Son and Holy Spirit. God has abundantly revealed himself as the Father who creates, the Son who redeems and saves and the Holy Spirit who sanctifies.

God's love for humanity moves him to give his Son for the salvation of all who believes in him. God's purpose for sending his Son was to save the world and not to condemn it. God condemns no one. God's offer of salvation through his Son is a gift which must be received with faith, that is, by believing in the one through whom salvation is to be achieved. Anyone who refuses to believe in the One (Jesus Christ) through whom salvation is to be attained has already condemned himself/herself.
