GOSPEL REFLECTION (Mark 1:40-45)

Again in this gospel we find Jesus moved with pity. Leprosy was a living death: the sufferer was isolated from family and community, and had to cry out 'Unclean, unclean!' when anyone approached. Touching the leper made Jesus ritually unclean also. There are no lengths to which Jesus will not go to help this man. He touches him, speaks to him, and gives him his freedom to be fully human again.

Leprosy was a term which covered a variety of skin diseases. In Jewish law any or all of them made the victim unclean. Lepers were often banished from society lest they might infect others. For Jesus to touch a leper was shocking. But in this way Jesus shows his closeness to us in our need. We thank him for this.

The leper becomes a disciple – he spreads the word. He witnesses to Jesus' goodness. Can we let him take us by the hand so that we too may become witness to what God is doing in our lives?
