*A reflection on **TODAY'S GOSPEL** Mark 3: 20-35*

In today's Gospel, Jesus' family is either frustrated with him, or worried about him. They hear that Jesus is drawing crowds again, and they go to restrain him—because people are talking. Some people think he is odd, and his family could be either embarrassed, or worried of what might become of him.

But, Jesus doesn't seem to mind all that much. After all, he knows how badly it's all going to turn out. So what did he do? He opened up the tent and allowed everyone who wants to enter the chance to enter.

Who is his family? Those who do the will of God. When you do the will of God you get the chance to be his brother, his sister... even his mother.

Jesus' family is an open family. The door to the family home is open wide.

And while the rest of us may bring dysfunction in the door with us - and at times we can look like a group of misfits...the things we gain are wonderful. And the greatest of those things is love.
