*A parishioner's reflection on **TODAY'S GOSPEL** Mark 14: 12-16, 22-26*

The preparation for an important meal is significant, with time and care being given to it.

Jesus' instructions were simple and ordinary, not lavish and demanding. The context was the Passover, which commemorated the liberation of the Hebrews from slavery, with the meal being celebrated in that spirit. Unleavened bread and wine were part of the ritual celebration.

Jesus became bread broken for us. The cup of blessing is the blood of the new covenant that would be poured out for us.

Jesus drew on simple everyday signs to present a profound message. His self-giving is complete, as are bread when it is eaten and wine when it is drunk. Nothing is left. As Eucharistic people we are to be taken, blessed, broken and given to others as Jesus was.

His continued presence among us gives us nourishment and we in turn nourish others.
