A reflection on **TODAY’S GOSPEL** Mark 10: 46-52

“Which group am I in?” The words of Pope Francis - 28 May 2015:

In light of this gospel reflection, Pope Francis proposed “an examination of conscience” that “will do us good”, through a series of direct questions: “Which group am I in?”

Am I in the **first group**, with those who don’t hear the many cries asking for the help of salvation? Am I concerned with only my relationship with Jesus, closed, selfish?

Do I belong to the **second group**, with those who separate people from Jesus, whether by lacking coherence in life, lacking testimony, whether by being too attached to money, or through rigidity? Do I distance people from Jesus?

Or do I belong to the **third group**, with those who hear the cry of so many people and help them to approach Jesus?

These are questions that, the Pope concluded, “each of us can answer in our heart”.
