### A REFLECTION on TODAY'S GOSPEL Luke 3:1-6

"Make the ground level"; "winding ways will be straightened" and "the rough roads made smooth" is seen as fulfilling the prophecy where there is a call to remove any obstacle that might stand in the way of God showing his salvation to his people.

This gospel reminds us of one of the key themes of Advent: repentance. Repentance and its associated colour purple remind many people of the season of Lent rather than Advent - but it is not difficult to see why it is so central to our preparation for the coming of Jesus.

Without it, the season of Christmas can simply slide into an excuse for over-indulgence, an opportunity to party in an effort to get over the darkness of winter.

The reading shows the true meaning of repentance; - leaving aside anything that might blind us to what God wants for us. Opening ourselves to something new and wonderful and beyond our wildest dreams: *God coming in the person of his Son.*
