A Reflection on today's Gospel Luke 4:1-13

Jesus was brought out of the ordinary into a place where he was tempted off-course. Three temptations ... **to comfort, power, wealth.** Even today those three ways can take us over.

Like us all. Money, power and comfort can lead us astray – wanting wealth; to be number one; and prioritise comfort in various ways.

Jesus' words go back to the word of God to find strength and insight to fight off evil. Words he learned at home - or in school.

A big source of energy for us is the word of God. On Ash Wednesday the invitation was to believe the good news. That is where we may find life and strength.

We remain in the church not because of bishops or even improvements in structures, but because of Jesus Christ. The word of God in his gospel remains life-giving and strong.

Today's Gospel shows us that temptations happen often to take us off the path. At a time when church life leaves us a bit down and weak, it is the spirit who led Jesus into the desert keeps him strong there, and will do the same for us.

Something for Lent: Read a bit of the gospel every day. Read the gospel to the children. Maybe look up your own favourite gospels. Simply: just pray.
