### A Reflection on today's Gospel Luke 6: 39-45

Did you ever complain about the behaviour of somebody else, then later realise you had some of the same fault yourself?

Was that a wake-up call?

Jesus says it is better to correct our own faults than complain about the faults of others.

If we want to help other people we need to have our feet on the ground, fully aware of our own gifts and limitations. Otherwise we will be impractical, like the blind leading the blind. What has helped you to be realistic about what you can and cannot do?

"No good tree bears bad fruit, nor again does a bad tree bear good fruit." This parable invites us to examine our motives. If our basic motivation is love, our lives will bear good fruit. If we lack love, the fruits will be conflict, disharmony and abuse of people for our own selfish ends.
