<u>A Reflection on today's Gospel - Matthew 11: 2-11</u>

There is real comfort in this story. John the Baptist, the powerful, austere man who held such a sway among the Jews, still had his moments of darkness.

Imprisoned in Herod's dungeon, he wondered: "Am I a fool?"; "Is this all there is?"; "Was I wrong about Jesus?" But he does not just brood on the question; he sends messengers to Jesus.

But Jesus does not send back reassurances; he just asks the messengers to open their eyes and see the evidence of Jesus' life.

Great as John was, we see that he did not live with pure certainty. He followed in faith - even as he allowed good questions to be asked.

We can pray that we may ask the right questions and, like John the Baptist, always direct them to Jesus.

"Lord, in my moments of doubt and darkness, may I fill my eyes with you."
